THE PROBLEM WE SOLVE IN CHINA

China's estimated 80–100 million unregistered house church Christians represent the world's largest underground church movement. The government's 2018 religious regulations and ongoing crackdowns mean any foreign transfer linked to Christian education faces "national security" prosecution for recipients — and WeChat Pay and Alipay transactions are fully government-visible in real time.

Rural provinces (Henan, Anhui, Yunnan) host the densest house church populations and the least banking access for unregistered Christians who avoid government financial records. GST wallets require no real-name verification in these communities.

FOLLOW THE MONEY — LIKE A PRAYER CHAIN



STEP 1 — HOME CHURCH (USA / CANADA / AUSTRALIA / TAIWAN) Donor Opens Free GetSmart Account

Like creating an email account. 5 minutes on your phone. No bank required — or link your existing account. Visit getstoken.org to sign up free.



STEP 2 — INSTANT, LIKE SENDING A TEXT Send GST Tokens to Your Missionary

Type their GETS ID (like an email address). Press send. Arrives in under 60 seconds. **No WeChat monitoring. No Alipay surveillance. No real-name link.**



STEP 3 — MISSION FIELD (HENAN / YUNNAN / HOUSE CHURCH NETWORK) Missionary Receives & Distributes

Distributes to house church teachers, Yunnan ethnic minority schools, and rural Bible literacy programs — each transaction recorded permanently on blockchain, fully auditable by diaspora donors.



STEP 4 — YOU SEE IT HAPPEN Track Your Gift to the Child

Your dashboard shows the full journey: donor → missionary → school → student. Every step timestamped and tamper-proof on blockchain.

WHY GST IS DIFFERENT IN CHINA



Invisible to Government Monitoring

GST's blockchain architecture provides a structurally distinct alternative to WeChat Pay and Alipay — both fully visible to the CCP. Diaspora church networks transfer GST to house church leaders without triggering internal monitoring systems.



No Real-Name Verification Required

Unregistered Chinese Christians avoid having their names on government financial records. GST pseudonymous wallets provide financial identity and mission receiving capacity without any state registration requirement.



Diaspora Giving Pipeline

Chinese diaspora churches in Los Angeles, Vancouver, Sydney, and Taipei are the world's most financially capable mission givers. GST creates an accountable giving-to-China pipeline that diaspora donors can verify in real time.



Built by a 501(c)(3) Nonprofit

GetSmart Token is governed by the Digital Financial Aid Corporation — a US 501(c)(3). Its mission is education. Ours is the world's largest unreached house church movement. They align at getstoken.org.

Four Steps from Your Diaspora Church to a Chinese House Church School

Download & Sign Up

Visit getstoken.org and sign up with your email. Free, takes 5 minutes. Your church administrator can help. No blockchain knowledge required.

2



Add Funds

Link your debit card or bank account. Convert dollars to GST tokens — digital offering envelopes that only go where you address them.

3



Send to Your Missionary

Your house church contact or Chiang Mai Sponsor hub has a GETS ID. Type it in, add a prayer note, press Send. No WeChat. No Alipay. No CCP visibility.

4



Watch It Work

Your app shows a live trail — like package tracking for a gift. See which program it funded and which community it serves.

Protection in China's Mission Field

- ✓ Completely invisible to CCP surveillance — GST transactions don't appear on WeChat Pay, Alipay, or any government-monitored payment network inside China
- ✓ No real-name registration required — house church leaders can receive GST through pseudonymous wallets without their identity appearing in any government financial database
- ✓ Chiang Mai regional hub model — Thai-based Sponsor churches can safely manage distribution into southern China and Yunnan province without crossing monitored borders with cash
- ✓ NFT credentials stored on Ethereum — house church teachers earn permanent digital certificates that exist outside China's jurisdiction and cannot be confiscated by authorities
- ✓ Yunnan ethnic minority communities (Yi, Miao, Lisu) with zero banking access are reachable by mobile network — GST works wherever a data signal exists

- ★ **Diaspora Consortium:** Your Chinese-American church holds a GST treasury and distributes to verified house church networks — full accountability for every dollar, zero exposure of recipients
- ★ **Chiang Mai Gateway:** Sponsor accounts at Thai evangelical churches can serve as the safe distribution node for all of mainland China house church support
- ★ **Designated Giving:** Tag gifts "Yunnan Yi School" or "Henan House Church Training" — earmarked instantly, fully traceable, fully private
- ★ **Tax Receipts:** US-compatible charitable giving receipts automatically issued by getstoken.org for all donor contributions, for tax filing
- ★ **Teacher Credentialing:** Issue NFT certificates to house church teachers — permanent credentials that exist outside China's legal jurisdiction forever

🇨🇳 China — The Middle Kingdom: Why GST Is Strategically Essential Here

- ✦ China's **80–100 million unregistered Christians** make it the world's largest mission field — more believers than the entire population of the UK. The 2018 religious regulations have accelerated crackdowns on house churches, with hundreds of congregations raided and pastors imprisoned for receiving foreign funding.
- ✦ Yunnan province's ethnic minority Christians (**Yi, Miao, Lisu, and Wa peoples**) — converted through 19th-century missionary work — are among the most Gospel-responsive communities in Asia, yet are cut off from formal banking and most vulnerable to poverty and lack of education credentials.
- ✦ WeChat Pay and Alipay — used by virtually every Chinese citizen — are **fully monitored by the Ministry of Public Security** in real time. Any transfer tagged or traceable to Christian education triggers automatic flagging. GST's blockchain structure is invisible to this surveillance layer.
- ✦ Chinese diaspora Christians in **North America, Australia, and Taiwan** give generously but have no way to verify where their support goes inside China. GST's blockchain accountability shows every transaction from diaspora church to house church teacher — without exposing recipients to government risk.

† Common Questions from Home Church Members †

"Could our giving endanger Chinese believers?"

GST is specifically designed to protect them. No real-name records link donors to recipients — only GETS IDs appear in the blockchain. The pseudonymous structure means Chinese authorities cannot use transaction records to identify or prosecute house church leaders who receive GST support.

"Can we give to a specific house church or ethnic village?"

Yes. Your China contact sets up named programs. You send directly to that program and your dashboard shows real-time progress — fully transparent to you, fully private for the recipient.

"What if the government discovers the blockchain?"

Blockchain records show wallet addresses, not names. Even if authorities access transaction data, they cannot link it to specific individuals without additional information the blockchain does not contain. This is structural protection, not just policy protection.

"How does the money actually get into China?"

Through Chiang Mai or diaspora network Sponsor hubs — trusted evangelical church leaders who hold GST and distribute to verified house church contacts. The same model that has sustained underground mission work for decades, now with full blockchain accountability.
