## THE PROBLEM WE SOLVE IN KENYA

Kenya is East Africa's most critical mission hub — home to the continent's largest evangelical networks, refugee ministry infrastructure, and the gateway to South Sudan, Somalia, Ethiopia, and DRC. But **M-Pesa dominance** means all mobile money transactions are fully visible to Safaricom and the Kenya Revenue Authority. Foreign remittances to churches are increasingly tagged for tax scrutiny under the **Public Benefits Organizations Act**.

In northeastern Kenya (Garissa, Wajir, Mandera — near the Somalia border), Al-Shabaab influence means Christian workers and their funders face targeted violence. Publicly visible foreign transfers to frontier churches create life-threatening exposure. GST routes around all of this.

## FOLLOW THE MONEY — LIKE A PRAYER CHAIN



### STEP 1 — HOME CHURCH (USA / UK / CANADA / AUSTRALIA) Donor Opens Free GetSmart Account

Like creating an email account. 5 minutes on your phone. No bank required — or link your existing account. Visit [getstoken.org](https://getstoken.org) to sign up free.



### STEP 2 — INSTANT, LIKE SENDING A TEXT Send GST Tokens to Your Missionary

Type their GETS ID (like an email address). Press send. Arrives in under 60 seconds. **No M-Pesa visibility. No PBO Act scrutiny. Full amount arrives instantly.**



### STEP 3 — MISSION FIELD (NAIROBI / TURKANA / SOMALIA BORDER) Missionary Receives & Distributes

Distributes to Kibera and Mathare slum schools, Turkana pastoralist programs, and frontier church workers near the Somalia border — each transaction permanently on blockchain.



### STEP 4 — YOU SEE IT HAPPEN Track Your Gift to the Child

Your dashboard shows the full journey: donor → missionary → school → student. Every step timestamped and tamper-proof on blockchain.

## WHY GST IS DIFFERENT IN KENYA



### Invisible to M-Pesa Surveillance

Kenya's M-Pesa is the world's most advanced mobile money system — and fully visible to Safaricom, the KRA, and government security services. GST travels outside this infrastructure entirely, reaching slum pastors and frontier workers without appearing in any monitored financial system.



### East Africa's Mission Hub

Nairobi Sponsor churches can manage GST distribution not just for Kenya but as the regional hub for South Sudan, DRC, Uganda, and Ethiopia — one accountable treasury routing Kingdom resources across the continent's most critical mission field.



### Reaches Kakuma & Dadaab Refugees

Kenya's refugee camps hold 500,000+ people from South Sudan, Somalia, DRC, and Ethiopia. GST-funded education programs reach camp teachers and community leaders who have no access to formal banking services.



### Built by a 501(c)(3) Nonprofit

GetSmart Token is governed by the Digital Financial Aid Corporation — a US 501(c)(3). Its mission is education. Kenya's mission is East Africa. They align perfectly at [getstoken.org](https://getstoken.org).

## Four Steps from Your Pew to a Kibera Child's Classroom

### Download & Sign Up

Visit [getstoken.org](https://getstoken.org) and sign up with your email. Free, takes 5 minutes. Your church administrator can help. No blockchain knowledge required.

2



### Add Funds

Link your debit card or bank account. Convert dollars to GST tokens — digital offering envelopes that only go where you address them.

3



### Send to Your Missionary

Your Kenya missionary or Nairobi Sponsor hub has a GETS ID. Type it in, add a prayer note, press Send. No M-Pesa trail. No KRA flag. Arrives in seconds.

### Watch It Work

Your app shows a live trail — like package tracking for a gift. See which program it funded and which community it serves.

### Protection in Kenya's Mission Field

- ✓ Invisible to M-Pesa and Safaricom monitoring — GST travels entirely outside Kenya's mobile money infrastructure that is fully visible to government security services
- ✓ No PBO Act registration required — GST utility token transfers don't trigger the Public Benefits Organizations Act foreign-funding scrutiny framework
- ✓ Frontier church workers in Garissa and Wajir protected — no visible foreign funding paper trail that Al-Shabaab informants or hostile local officials can use to target Christian workers
- ✓ Reaches Kakuma and Dadaab refugee camp educators — only requires a mobile phone and data signal, bypassing the formal banking exclusion that affects 500,000+ camp residents
- ✓ East Africa regional hub capability — Nairobi Sponsor accounts can distribute GST across South Sudan, Ethiopia, DRC, and Uganda from a single accountable treasury

- ★ **East Africa Hub Account:** Your Nairobi Sponsor church becomes the regional GST hub — receiving from Western donors and distributing to verified missionaries across Kenya, South Sudan, DRC, Uganda, and Ethiopia
- ★ **Slum Church Network:** Designate GST for Kibera, Mathare, and Korogocho church-based school programs — each tagged separately for full donor accountability
- ★ **Refugee Camp Fund:** Tag gifts specifically for Kakuma or Dadaab camp education — instantly earmarked, blockchain-verified, fully transparent to diaspora donors
- ★ **Tax Receipts:** US-compatible charitable giving receipts automatically issued by [getstoken.org](https://getstoken.org) for all contributions
- ★ **Teacher Credentialing:** Issue NFT certificates to slum school teachers and camp educators — permanent credentials that can never be taken by poverty, displacement, or conflict

### Kenya — East Africa's Mission Engine: Why GST Is Strategically Essential Here

- ♦ Nairobi hosts the **headquarters of more East African evangelical networks, missionary organizations, and theological colleges** than any other city on the continent — making Kenya the indispensable hub for reaching South Sudan, DRC, Somalia, and the Horn of Africa. GST's Nairobi hub model leverages this existing infrastructure.
- ♦ The Somalia border counties of **Garissa, Wajir, and Mandera** represent Kenya's most dangerous frontier mission zone — Al-Shabaab maintains significant influence, and Christian workers who receive identifiable foreign funding become targets. GST's invisible transfer architecture is a literal life-safety measure for these frontier missionaries.
- ♦ Kenya's Kibera slum — with **700,000+ residents** — is home to hundreds of church-based schools that are the only education available to the poorest urban children in East Africa. These schools are run by pastors on zero budget, dependent on foreign support that M-Pesa makes financially visible and taxable.
- ♦ Kakuma Refugee Camp (200,000+) and Dadaab Refugee Complex (200,000+) together host **400,000+ refugees** from South Sudan, Somalia, DRC, and Ethiopia — one of the world's largest concentrated mission opportunities, with a captive population of survivors hungry for education, community, and hope.

### † Common Questions from Home Church Members †

#### "Isn't M-Pesa the easiest way to send to Kenya?"

M-Pesa is fast and familiar — but every transaction is visible to Safaricom, the KRA, and government security services. For slum church pastors and especially frontier workers near the Somalia border, that visibility creates real risk. GST is equally fast but travels entirely outside the monitored M-Pesa infrastructure.

#### "Can we give to a specific Kibera school or Kakuma teacher?"

Yes. Missionaries set up named programs and you send directly. Your dashboard shows real-time progress — transparent to you, protected for your recipients in the slum or refugee camp.

#### "Can we fund the Nairobi hub and let them distribute regionally?"

Yes — this is exactly the model GST is built for. Your Nairobi Sponsor coordinator receives a shared GST treasury and distributes across Kenya, South Sudan, DRC, and Ethiopia. You see every downstream transaction on your dashboard, with each region tagged separately.

#### "What about the Somalia border — is it safe to send there?"

The invisible transfer architecture is specifically why GST is used for frontier workers. No M-Pesa record, no bank transfer record, and no public financial trail of any kind connects your donation to a specific church worker in Garissa or Wajir. That anonymity is a life-safety feature.
